Hello Friends,

As I write this, I'm preparing for our celebration of the Feast of the Ascension. This major feast day doesn't get a lot of attention these days, because it always falls on a Thursday. The opening chapter of the Acts of the Apostles sets the timeline.

Forty days after the resurrection, Luke tells us, Jesus led his disciples (only eleven at this time) out to Bethany. He "opens their minds" to understand what everything they've been taught and experienced says about who Jesus is. He then tells them to return to Jerusalem and wait to be "clothed with power from on high." Then, as he blesses them, he is taken up into the heavens.

Just then, a couple of messengers appear, wondering why the disciples are just standing there gazing up into the sky. Well, duh! If a companion of mine suddenly disappeared into the clouds while we were standing and talking, I would probably find it impossible to stop doing a bit of sky-gazing myself.

In our own time, we seem to be stuck in that sky-gazing position. Popular teaching has many watching and waiting, not amazed at Jesus' disappearance, but waiting around for his coming again. Meanwhile, that "power from on high," otherwise known as the Holy Spirit, keeps moving all around us, doing God's work while we twiddle our thumbs.

It's not like Jesus didn't give his disciples a to-do list. They are to proclaim repentance and forgiveness, starting from Jerusalem and moving outward from there. And, the word is "proclaim." Not demand, not require something of others. The job the disciples have is to let the whole world know that God desires a healthy working relationship with all the world, and to establish that has forgiven all that has separated God's creation and its creatures from their Creator.

But what about the repentance part, you might ask. Repentance is about turning our focus in the right direction. In this case, it's away from our own power (not necessarily from "on high," mind you) and status toward the God who has already forgiven us of our tendency to turn away from God. That may be a different understanding than what we've been used to hearing, but it is what Jesus really says.

Like the Feast of the Ascension, discipleship is not a thing of convenience. It is the foundation of the life of the Body of Christ, which is the true Church, and not the corporate institution or its structures. We become truly alive in Christ when we stop treating "church" as a convenience store where we stop by to get some bread when we realize we've run out.

But then that's how the corporate institution we call "church" seems to have established itself. It's time to let our minds be opened again to the scriptures to understand who Jesus is, and in turn who we are as his Body in our own time. Unlike those first eleven disciples, we don't have to hang around waiting for the Spirit to tell us what to do. That voice is all around us, waiting for us to pay attention.

What are we waiting for?
