

St. Paul's Episcopal— Outreach Updates "They had a need and asked..... And we gave."

- 1. Participated in Stuff a Bus We matched parishioners donations from our Outreach Fund. In 2023, the total donation was \$710. and in 2024 we increased that amount to \$806.00. The Stuff— A—Bus campaign collects supplies and distributes to children in our county. With our Parish history of having so many school teachers as members, it is a fitting cause.
- 2. We helped with staffing of the Spiritual Life Center at the fairgrounds. The building had sixteen different denominations. We welcomed more that 114 people. We hosted from 3-8pm. It was interesting to hear so many visitors didn't recognize our church but so many recognized us as the beautiful church on the circle with the red doors. So we are getting visual recognition out there. We just need to work more on the who we are and what we believe in, how we practice our brand of Episcopal faith in the greater Christian Community.
- 3. On Saturday September 7,2024, St. Paul's Episcopal will once again present our friendly Parish hospitality by providing fresh hot popcorn and ice—cold bottled water to visitors and participants during the downtown Greenville Fall Cruise-in car show. The popcorn and water is given out free. We accept donations, and proceeds are given to our collaborative outreach partner Grace Resurrection Community Center. We do intend to use it to increase community awareness of our parish.
